Once you answer each question, take the highlighted letters and place them in the matching numbered spaces below (keyed to the question number) to reveal the answer to the riddle. Answers below.

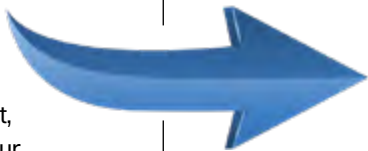
